Alliance Gives Cerner Web Access

(October 18, 2002) Cerner Corp., Kansas City, Mo., will integrate into its Millennium clinical information system Web-access software from Wellogic Inc., Cambridge, Mass. The alliance will enable Millennium clients to give physicians secure remote access to patient data from any computer with a Web browser.

Cerner expects to demonstrate the integrated technology later this year in its Vision Center at corporate headquarters; the company plans to have it commercially available in the first quarter of 2003. Cerner boasts nearly 400 clients running some 1,600 Millennium applications.
